

PERRINS REPORT – STAKEHOLDER INPUT INVITED

On December 21st the Government of Saskatchewan released the *Educational Governance Review Report, Kindergarten to Grade 12*. Dan Perrins was commissioned to write the report based on the question, “What system of governance and structure is needed in Saskatchewan’s K-12 education sector to achieve the outcomes established by the Saskatchewan Plan for Growth and the Education Sector Strategic Plan (ESSP)?” Within the report there is a review of the historical delivery of education in the province. The report provides possible considerations for the structure and governance of education in the province moving forward. The Government is seeking input from stakeholders. Within the process there are a couple of options for input if desired. Stakeholders are invited, if they are inclined, to make submissions either through an on-line forum or through an email submission. Boards of Education in the province have been invited to come before the Panel if they desire. The Board of Education of SECPD is scheduled to meet with the Panel.
