## TUITION APPROVAL

- Tuition charges of \$500 per course will be applied to all external and adult students (Age 22+ at the time of registration).
- Non-adult students who reside within the SE Cornerstone boundaries and do not attend another school will automatically be registered as Cyber Stone students. Tuition fees will not be charged.
- Home-based education students living within SE Cornerstone boundaries are not required to pay tuition for their 1<sup>st</sup> online class. These students will automatically become base to Cyber Stone, and no longer registered as home schoolers with South East Cornerstone, once they begin their 2<sup>nd</sup> online course. Tuition fees will not be charged.
